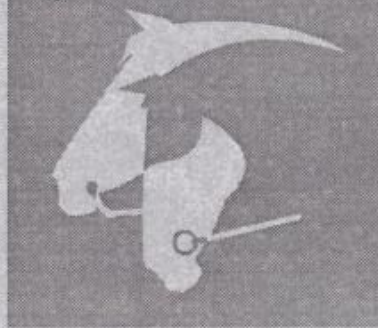

NAMHSA extends deep gratitude for their hours of volunteer labor. A job this large needs many willing hands, and we are blessed indeed to have these to support us.

The pre-show paperwork - the magnitude of which would leave the most experienced show-holder reeling, and without which the show would simply not be happening - was handled with great competency and efficiency by the following people...

Kate Cabot, NAMHSA Secretary: Its hard to begin describing the quantity and complexity of Kate's contribution; suffice to say that she had a hand in every step of the process of your chance to show here. From hours of entering results from ALL the member shows since the beginning of NAMHSA into the NAN database, to fielding the hundreds of calls from showers, to singing up new member shows and keeping track of dues, to facilitating registration, creation of the showers packets, initial classlist...the list is endless, and at times its a sure bet Kate thought so, as well! At NAN 1996 - as she was in 1995 - Kate can be found at the NAN computer during the show, quickly entering the data that will determine championships.

Ann Harris, NAN '96 Registration Clerk: Kate's right-hand help, Ann registered 110 people and their 1430 horses for this years' NAN. She also had the mind-numbing job of assembling and banding the ID tags for all those horses too! Look for her sharing showday data-entry duties with Kate Cabot.

Rob Harris, Computer Programmer: for both the NAN Entry Program and NAN Showday Program and assembler of the "mondo big NANdata" (our

database where we have over ten thousand qualified models and their owners on file for both the '96 showyear and the upcoming '97 showyear), designer of the new entry forms and all of the personalized forms for both qualification and entry, head of mailings for Qualification Notification (637 people received their Qualification Information this year), Head of NAN '96 Registration, provided all histograms and reports to the NAN Committee making it possible to get well over a thousand horses in the right classes on showday and to make sure judges were not assigned to classes where they had a conflict, last but not least, creator of the "NAN Binder of Knowledge" (all the forms needed for judging classes and their heats on showday). If it involved brilliant computer wizardry or mailing on a grand scale, Rob did it.

John Cabot: Software and hardware support to Kate Cabot and Rob Harris, providing "NANdata" help on many occasions giving up many weekends and evenings and vacation days in support of the many NAN jobs Kate and Rob took under their wings during the year. Head copy editor for the NAN Information Packets, both Qualification Notification and Showday. The fastest NAN Qualification Notification packet stuffer in the East— able to get over a hundred packets stuffed in under an hour!

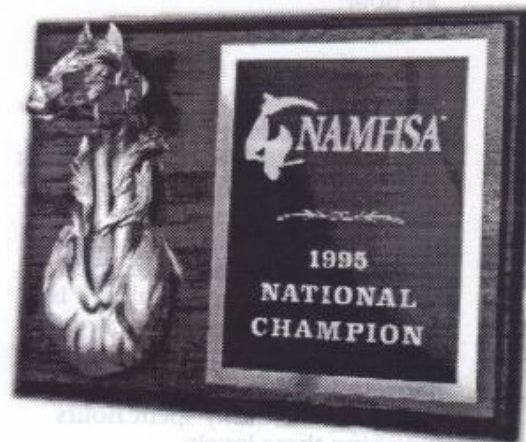
Debbie Moore, Auction Support: Debbie is providing the invaluable service of transporting,

OF PLASTIC OTHER SPORT & CARRIAGE BREEDS includes the following: Akhal-Teke, Hackney Horse, Karabair, Lokai, Spanish Norman, App/Trakehner Cross, Connemara/Mustang Cross, Dutch WB, Friesian, Furioso, Hanoverian, Holsteiner, Oldenburg, Orlov Trotter, Swedish WB and Trakehner.

OF PLASTIC APPALOOSA includes Appaloosa/Thoroughbred crosses, since this cross is accepted by the ApHC for registration.

OF PLASTIC PAINT includes all Paint Horses.

OF PLASTIC QUARTER HORSE includes Quarter Horse/Thoroughbred crosses, since this cross is accepted by the AQHA for registration.
