

## **This is a cross-reference list for entering your horses at NAN.**

It will tell you how a breed is classified for NAN so that you can easily find the correct division in which to show your horse. If your breed is designated "other pure," with no division indicated, the NAN committee will use body type and suitability to determine in what division it belongs.

Note: For the purposes of NAN, NAMHSA considers breeds that routinely fall at 14.2 hands high or less to be ponies.

Note: Show Cobs as listed here are not a breed; they are a type. The British Show Horse Registry is a performance registry similar to the National Cutting Horse Association. It does not record bloodlines; one just has to register your horse to participate in sanctioned shows. A registration lasts one year and only requires a valid UK horse passport and a certified height measurement.

From their registration rules:

**Conditions of Registration**

Horses must be registered annually. Only registered Horses, including Novices, may be entered in Affiliated classes. Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of two 'Day Tickets' per Exhibitor, per Rider, per Horse, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, but not RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered using the 'Day Ticket' DO NOT require a JMB Height Certificate until full registration.

Only horses that have paid the current HOYS Levy will be eligible to qualify and compete at the Horse of the Year Show in the current year.
